

# Warrenton Middle School Sports Guidelines 2014-2015



## I. Student athlete requirements

-Current VHSL physical on file with Athletic Coordinator (doctor visit after May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014.)

-Concussion History form on file with Athletic Coordinator.

-Concussion Acknowledgment form on file with Athletic Coordinator.

-Solid academic and behavioral standing with the school.

-Grade checks will be performed by the Athletic Coordinator after the 4<sup>th</sup> game of the season to check student academic eligibility.

**-\$60 athletic fee** for students that are selected to the school team.\*

-Parents **will be required to transport** their child to and from practices and games (bus transportation will not be provided this year.)

## II. Sport Seasons

-**Fall Season** includes boys baseball and girls soccer. Try-outs begin Wednesday, August 20<sup>th</sup> through Friday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>.

-Games begin September 9<sup>th</sup> and end on October 9<sup>th</sup>.

-**Fall Season 2** includes girls basketball. Try-outs begin on October 13<sup>th</sup>.

-Games begin October 30<sup>th</sup> and end on December 11<sup>th</sup>.

-**Winter Season** includes boys basketball. Try-outs begin January 8<sup>th</sup>.

-Games begin January 27<sup>th</sup> and end on March 3<sup>rd</sup>.

-**Spring Season** includes girls softball and boys soccer. Try-outs begin on March 16<sup>th</sup>.

-Games begin April 14<sup>th</sup> and will end on May 14<sup>th</sup>.

### **III. Miscellaneous**

- Intramurals will be held on **Wednesdays**. There will be three sessions offered and each session lasts six weeks. Information about the sessions and specific clubs offered will be available by the end of August.
- Intramurals fee is still **\$35** for each club. (Some clubs might be a bit more expensive depending on materials needed.)
- Information about the upcoming sports teams can be found on [www.warrentonwarriors.org](http://www.warrentonwarriors.org). An app can be downloaded to your cell phone as well that will update practice or game changes called “Big Teams” for \$1.99.
- Local businesses can also advertise on the Warriors sports page, similar to the structure of the high school pages. More information will be forthcoming.
- Student academic eligibility for sports requires that at the midseason grade check the athlete is passing **5** of 7 classes (**all core classes** must have a passing grade.)
- A more concrete code of conduct form will be issued to students that are selected for the school team that specifies requirements and expectations.

\*The athletic fee is assigned for each sports team that a student participates in. Students in the free and reduced lunch program will pay an adjusted fee due to economic hardship.
